







Olympic Equestrian Centre & Athens Race Course, Greece

The "Markopoulo Olympic Equestrian Centre" in Athens, scene of the Olympic Equestrian Games 2004, is one of our most famous planning projects. Here we developed a master plan for an area of 250 hectares including the concepts for the riding facilities and buildings.

Besides the core of the Olympic Games, the riding stadium with the visitors-, VIP- and

press areas, an event and training arena, stables complexes and a vast cross-country-course have been built.

The other main focus on this site was the Athens Race Course including the Grand stand and the stables. The daily training facilities on the race course were completed by a jockey school.







15. Asian Games in Doha, Qatar 2006

The Asian Games 2006 have taken place in Doha/Qatar. In the run-up to the games the Equestrian centre and a new race course with a training area for 400 horses have to be built almost completely new. For this extensive project our office was instructed to design the master plan and buildings.

The core is the race course with the grandstand. It sepa-

rates the training area for the thoroughbred horses with the clinic and the club-building from the equestrian event centre for dressage and jumping with its several training grounds, stable areas and the indoor event arena for 2.000 visitors.





Equestrian Event Centre at the National Stud of Brandenburg in Neustadt, Dosse, Germany

In 1999 the Event Centre at the National Stud in Neustadt (Dosse) has been built with public funds as the biggest multifunctional hall in the federal state of Brandenburg. With an inside riding ground of 28 x 70 m the arena is suitable for all international equestrian events and provides seats for up to 3.000 visitors. The "Earl-of-Lindenau-Hall", named after the founder of the National Stud, is multifunctional be-

cause of its removable wooden floor covering. Because of this features additionally cultural events and trade fairs can be organized, too.

The design of the hall fits into the historical facilities of the stud. Especially the arrangement of the façade and the construction of the roof adept harmoniously to the historic buildings from the 18th century.





Dressage Facilities of Beatriz Ferrer-Salat in Barcelona, Spain

The design of the riding facilities of Spanish dressage rider Beatriz Ferrer-Salat, repeated member of the Olympic team, was another demanding task. A high-quality training centre with a riding hall and a related stable complex for 35 horses has been planned on a vast site of an historical farm.

Both the facade and the interior have been designed in

every detail, so that there is no wish left for training on the highest level.

The existing farm has been redeveloped. Now it serves as a residence with several staff accommodations. Moreover horse boxes are located in the farm.

In cooperation with a local office the project has been coordinated and realized.





Scuderia Aletti-Montano in Varese, Italy

Since the 19th century the Aletti family has been breeding thoroughbred horses which took place in the best European race courses.

In Varese, in the north of Italy, a new high-quality training centre has been created by our office with a training track of 1,200 metres length and 8 metres width. Beside the track a stable divided between two floors and with boxes for 124 horses, space for washing horses,

farrier, veterinary examinations, saddle rooms and storages has been built. A complex for staff and administration with offices, conference rooms, relaxation rooms, kitchen and changing-rooms has been established in the centre of the stable.

The scuderia Aletti-Montano is located in a wonderful landscape at the Lago di Varese.





Entertainment City, Tehran, Iran

One of our most extended master plan designs, over an area of round about 280 hectares, is located in Tehran, Iran.

The main subject for this area is leisure and sport with the priority on equestrian sport. Therefore a new race course with a dirt track including a 1,000 m straight and an inner grass track is planned. The racing facilities are completed with a grand stand and

stables for about 600 horses. Moreover an equestrian center is located on the site with an indoor arena, a stadium, several training grounds and stables. For the racing and equestrian facilities a separate quarantine area and a vet clinic are included.

In addition several leisure components like a golf course, a water park, an ice skating hall and a shopping mall are located on the site.





Indoor Arena at the German Olympic-Committee for Equestrian in Warendorf

One of our long term clients is the German Olympic Committee for Equestrian.

A new indoor event and training arena with a riding ground of 25 x 65 metres, a gallery for 300 visitors and a new stable complex has been built as an extension to the existing facilities and serves for the education of the German high performance riders and young talents. Here they can be coached on the high-

est level in a very bright and high quality indoor arena.

In the neighborhood to the Olympic Committee a lot of equestrian facilities has been realized by our office, like the administration building of the National Equestrian Federation of Gemrany, several private riding facilities and the concept "Living with Horses", explained in the following pages.





Hönyhof, Thoroughbred Stud in Oberaula, Germany

A new thoroughbred stud was designed and realized for the stud "Hönyhof" of the Hellwig family in Oberaula, in the federal state of Hesse in the south of the town Kassel.

A high quality stable complex, which fits well in the landscape, has been built for the breeding of 30 horses on a vast area surrounded by paddocks and pastures at

the access of the town. The stable, which is built up in a frame work with the combination of clinker and plaster, contains a modern and spacious interior. The ensemble of the stud is completed by an office and stud directors house including staff accommodations.

The building and the landscape have been realized with a lot of love for details.





Thoroughbred training centre, Stud Schlenderhan, Bergheim, Germany

In 2006 a training centre has been established for the oldest and most successful German thoroughbred stud Schlenderhan. A very modern and comfortable stable complex for 70 thoroughbreds with a covered trotting ring, storage, office building and a staff accommodation has been built on the neighborhood of the stud, which already was realized by our office in 1989.

The core of this training facility is the race track of 2,200

metres length with a straight line of 1,000 metres. There is a 30 metres wide grass track and a 5,50 metres wide sand track available for daily training. The tracks are constructed according to the most modern findings. After moving into the new facilities Schlenderhan was able to win the German Gallop Derby, the most imprtant race comepetition in Germany - both in 2007 and 2009. It was the first victory for the stud in this legendary race since 31 years.







Royal Oman Police Stable Complex, Wattayah, Oman

The Royal Oman Police plans to build a completely new equestrian centre with accommodation and education facilities. The whole complex should be for 600 horses, 300 camels, 1,000 dogs and 1,200 police officers.

In addition to the stable complex the equestrian facility includes a large sized indoor arena (80 metres x 100 metres), a race track, a veterinary clinic and several outside rid-

ing arenas. The largest arena is located inside of the race track in front of a high quality grand stand with a multifunctional building beside. Equestrian events in different disciplines could take place here. The architectural competition for this project runs in summer 2012 and we participate in cooperation with an international engineering office.





Living with horses

The idea of "Living with Horses", which has been developed first by our office in 1989, enables living door to door with their own horses in a special declared building area.

A community of riders and families with horse minded persons can purchase sites from 3,000 up to 5,000 square metres and thus

built up stables and paddocks closed to their dwelling houses. In Germany this is normally only possible for farmers outside a town. Common facilities like riding grounds and halls complete the so called "special building areas for riding". Thus horse husbandry and riding have become possible for every private leisure rider close to the city.





Stud Lindhof in Wallern, Austria

One of our most exclusive projects has been built in Wallern, Lower Austria. Mr. and Mrs. Seifert have realized their dream of a stud according to an historical example.

In the centre of the 28 hectares large terrain a mansion with a symmetrical stable building form a closed yard plant which is accessible by

two gates. The stable provides boxes for 25 horses. The complex decorated facades continue inside the stable with its pillars and vaults.

The installation is completed with an indoor riding arena of 20 x 60m with a direct access to the stable. The park and pastures are located axial around the building.






